Top of class in regulation

Medical products are subject to many important regulations and requirements. Invacare is proud to be leading the way in complying with these standards to ensure that all products adhere to the latest requirements. Specialist teams of employees are dedicated to performing testing, risk assessments and compliance reviews. Invacare adheres to recognised standards including ISO 13485 (Quality Standard of medical products) and harmonised norms such as EN 12183 (for manual wheelchairs) and EN 12184 (for powered wheelchairs) which include essential requirements relating to fire retardancy and biocompatibility.

After intensive internal testing, all *Invacare*[®] products are voluntarily released for independent external testing by **TUV** and **CERAH**.

When applicable, *Invacare®* products comply with the **ISO 7176-19** crash test standard, again externally confirmed by recommended and certified test institutes. The **CE**-mark and CE-declaration of conformity on the products confirms that the Company fully complies with all the requirements.




Invacare in Europe

In practice

The elevating legrest, 80° hanger, 90° hanger and amputee support are compatible across all *Invacare* Passive and Medium Active wheelchairs and are also interchangeable with some Power, Active and Low Active wheelchairs. The flip-up and angle- and depth-adjustable footplates are also cross-compatible within the Passive and Active ranges and with some other product families.

Invacare offers many different types of armrest: padded, hemiplegic, removable, swing-away,

mud guard, etc. Most of these are cross-compatible with Medium Active and Passive wheelchairs and

are interchangeable with some Low Active, Active and Power wheelchairs.

Solid, pneumatic, aluminium or anti-slip hand-rim rear wheels are cross-compatible across Medium Active and Passive products and are interchangeable with some Active and Low Active wheelchairs.
