


Effective pressure injury prevention

The Invacare Softform Excel provides a high level of comfort and is constructed from high specification foam which provides even weight distribution for greater comfort and pressure redistribution. With a robust foam base, it prevents the mattress from bottoming out and is suitable for those considered at risk of developing pressure injuries.

The core of the Invacare Softform Excel is constructed from a series of 'keyhole cut' cells, which move independently to evenly distribute weight, promoting greater comfort and facilitating pressure redistribution.

The robust base features a firm layer of high density foam to provide substantial support.

The cover fabric provides excellent recovery and durability, and helps to reduce shear and friction forces. The base of the mattress is a tough coated polyurethane (PU) which protects the mattress when used with electric profiling bed frames.

A range of assessment scales can be used as a formal method of assessing risk from pressure injury development, and should be used in conjunction with an informal assessment (informed nursing judgement). Informal assessment is considered to be of greater importance and clinical value.
